# SCHOOL OF ARTS AND SCIENCES WEBSITE

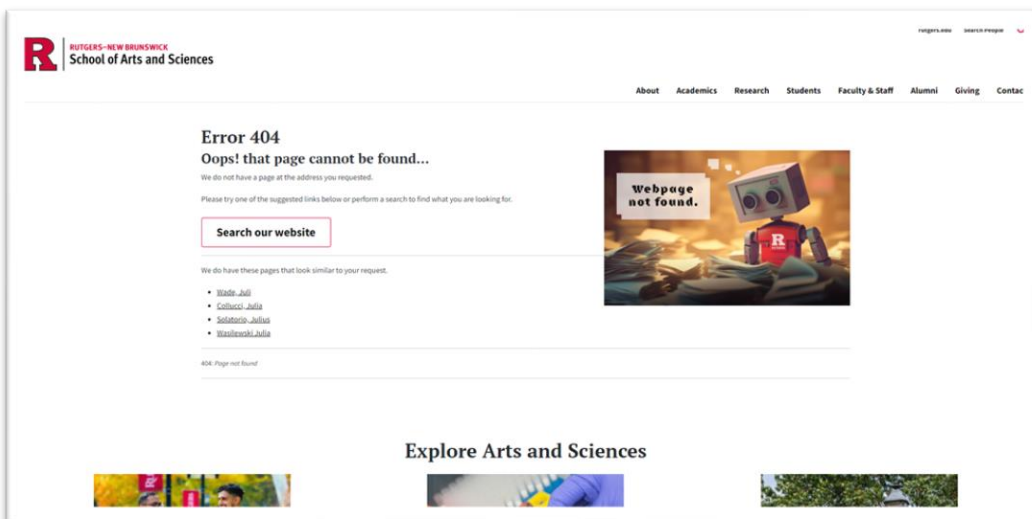
